Did you know that God loves you more than anyone else could ever love you?

God proves His love to you by providing **His fulfilling** love to you. **Rom. 13:10** *“Love does no harm to a neighbor. Therefore love is the fulfillment of the law.”*

The Hebrew word for **fulfillment** in this passage is *pleroma* which means *to fill up to the top or to bring to completeness*. The love that God has given us is a completion of His purpose for us. He wants every person to know and experience how much He loves them. It is the completion of His law and His plan for everyone. It was and is because of His love that everything He has or will do is completed. **Phil 2:9** *“It is God Who works in you both to will and to do His good pleasure.”*
