Because God loves you, He Provides- Part 81

Did you know that God loves you more than anyone else could ever love you?

God proves His love to you by giving us His **strengthening love**. **Isa. 40:28-29** *“Do you not know? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and His understanding no one can fathom. He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.”*

The Hebrew word for **strength** is *koach* which means power, might, ability or able to do great things. Do you ever just feel like you’ve run out of energy; like you need some kind of boost or recharging? I think we all have. There are days that you hit the ground running and before you know it, the day is gone and the next one is starting.

Life can be physically, mentally, emotionally, and even spiritually draining. No wonder energy drinks have become so popular. Many just feel like they need something extra to make it. Like the TV announcer might put it: “Have I got great news for you!” It doesn’t come in a pill or a can. **Ps. 121:2** *“My help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth.”* He never grows tired or weary. He has all power and all strength and He gives the strength that we need when we need it. He comforts the broken-hearted. He heals the sick. He encourages the down-trodden. He gives wisdom to the ones who seek Him. You think you’ve got a tight schedule...His never ends. In today’s verse, there is an interesting caveat. His strength never, ever runs out. He doesn’t need a re-charge or ten days in Maui, to get replenished. He never needs more strength because He has it all. He is our perfect and complete Father Who just continues eternally, without fail. Do you see your Father like that? Read the words of Paul to the believers in Ephesus: **Eph. 3:20-21** *“Now to Him Who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work in us, to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.”*

Dear Father, thank You that you have all strength and power and that we can come to You to find the strength we need for this day. You are our only hope LORD. You can take the weakest in us and make it strong by Your great power. We look to You and You alone. In Jesus Name, Amen
