Because God loves you, He Provides- Part 44

Did you know that God loves you more than anyone else could ever love you?

God proves His love to you by providing **His blessing** to you. **2 Cor. 9:8**, *“And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.”*

The Greek word here for **ble**ss is *perissos* which means more, greater, excessive, abundant and exceedingly. Doesn't this sound like our Heavenly Father? He is always wanting to bless us beyond what we could ever think or imagine. You see He doesn't provide *most* things that you need. He provides *all* things, at *all* times, having *all* that you need. His blessings to us are more than we could ever hope for or dream about. The blessings of God for you are limited only to God Himself; and what limits can hold His power, strength, ability or love?

I believe He wants to bless us even more than we can comprehend. We limit Him only with our unbelief. There is no end to His ability to bless us. **Num. 6:24-26**, *“The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face shine on you and be gracious to you; the LORD turn His face toward you and give you peace.”* And **Eph. 1:3**, *“Praise be to the God and Father of our LORD Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.”*

This is not a message of *name it and claim it* as some would try to tell you. Instead, it is simply the fact that God, because of His great love for you, wants to bless you in every way by providing Himself to you. Paul states it correctly in **Phil. 4:12-13**, *“I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. For I can do all things through Christ, Who gives me strength.”*

Hasn't God blessed you in so many ways? We need to recognize His blessings and thank Him for them. *God is so good, He's so good to me.*

Dear Father, thank You for the way You bless us every day. You are all we need. Help us to be grateful for the way You provide for us. We can be a very selfish lot. Draw our eyes and hearts to You. In Jesus Name, Amen
