God proves His love to you by **being saved from His wrath**. **Rom. 5:9** *“Since we have now been justified by His blood, how much more shall we be saved from God’s wrath through Him!”*

The Greek term for *wrath* is *orges* which means *anger, punishment or vengeance*. I believe that we, as humans, cannot truly yet conceive the wrath of an angry God.
