God proves His love to you by **His illuminating love, Part B. Ps. 27:1** ***“The LORD is my light and my salvation-whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life-of whom shall I be afraid?”***

The Greek word for light again is *phos* which means *light, especially in terms of its results and what it manifests*. We get our word photo from this word. The Lord is the picture of my salvation.
