The Names of Love - Part 32 - Jesus The Savior - Yeshua, Iesous Soter

Mt. 1:20-21, “Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will give birth to a son, and you are to give Him the name Jesus, because He will save His people from their sins.”

This name of Jesus literally means “Yahweh is Salvation.”

Acts 4:12 states “salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name given under heaven by which we must be saved.”

I love how Ann Spangler puts it - From the beginning the single purpose of Jesus’ life was to seek out sinners and then to save them. He was God hunting souls, not to hurt them but to help them—and that is still His purpose.

Jesus is the only means of salvation. There is no other name. There is no other way. If there were, then Jesus did not have to come to earth, be born of a virgin, live a sinless life, be brutalized, tortured, crucified, and die. He did this as God’s only answer to our sin. He is our salvation. He is our only hope. From the beginning, the single purpose of Jesus’ life was to seek out sinners and then to save them. He was God hunting souls.... And by the way, He still is. Phil. 2:9-11, “Therefore God exalted Him to the highest place and gave Him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus, every knee shall bow, in Heaven and on Earth and under the Earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is LORD, to the glory of God the Father.”
