The Names of Love - Part 38 - The Good Shepherd - Poimen Kalos

John 10:11, "I AM the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down His life for the sheep."

This name of Jesus literally means "The Good Shepherd" and "The Sacrificial Lamb"
