The Names of Love - Part 28 - LION OF THE TRIBE OF JUDAH

Rev. 5:4-5, “I wept and wept because no one was found who was worthy to open the scroll or look inside. Then one of the elders said to me, “Do not weep! See, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has triumphed. He is able to open the scroll and its seven seals.”
