The Names of Love - Part 29 - LORD, Kyrios

Rom. 8:38-39, “For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, the present nor the future, any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God is in Christ Jesus our LORD.”

This Greek word Kyrios is used to refer to someone who is an owner, king, or master. It correlates to the Hebrew word Adonai. The term LORD in scripture depicts THE LORD. There is no one higher than He. There is no one as Holy as He is. There is no one more powerful than our LORD. He is above all things in all of creation!

What this means is that Jesus can only become “your” Savior when you choose to follow Him as LORD. He doesn’t just give you a blessing by your joining a church or by being baptized, but instead He is looking for those who will repent of their own ways and turn to Him as the Only Way. He is the way, and the truth, and the life. No one will come to the Father except through Him.

Read this amazing promise in God’s word today: 2 Pet. 3:8-10, “But do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day. The Lord is not slow in keeping His promise, as some understand slowness. He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance. But the day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar; the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything in it will be laid bare.”

Are you ready to meet the Lord? You can be. Give your life to Him. Trust in His salvation through Jesus Christ our LORD. He loves you that much!
