God proves His love to you by **His sustaining love**. **Ps. 55:22** *"Cast your cares on the LORD, and He shall sustain you; He shall never let the righteous be shaken."*

The Hebrew word for *sustain is yechalkelecha* which means to hold, to provide for, to nourish, to give provision or sustain. The picture here is that God will continue to hold on to you and never let you go. And not only will He hold you, He will provide for your needs and uphold you in your darkest times.
